We are offering a Company-Sponsored Master's degree at ESA with a major **French International Dairy Production Company**

- A **certified B2 level in English** (equivalent of 700 points in TOEIC)
- a desire to learn new cultures and a new language (French)
- a real capacity to overcome challenges and to develop new competencies
- an experience abroad would be appreciated
- **PLEASE NOTE: NO FRENCH REQUIRED TO APPLY**

You must be under 25 on September 1st 2020 to apply.

Deadline: February 10th, 2020. Only fully completed application files will be examined.

The selection process is in two steps. ESA will examine your application and will contact you for a first interview in English by one of their team. If ESA decides you are a solid candidate we will pass your file on to the company.

ESA will arrange company interviews in Croatia in early March 2020. The company makes the final choice. The program begins in early April 2020 for those who need French lessons and late July 2020 for French speakers.
