Hence, our Photonics Master track is jointly provided by leading centers for optics education in Europe: Imperial College London, Institut d'Optiqué Paris, Technical University Delft, and Warsaw University of Technology.

The program is part of a full scale education program at the Faculty of Physics and Astronomy at the Friedrich-Schiller-Universität Jena specialized in Optics & Photonics, starting for the Bachelor level, continuing in the master program, and culminating in a structured PhD program.
